Certificate in Research Enrichment

The SSARC offers a Research certificate for all undergraduates interested in enhancing their education with research skills and network development. Requiring two courses and involvement in research with a faculty, the certification facilitates the study of research methods and experience. The knowledge and skills gained through the required curriculum is valuable for various professions (ranging from business, education, social work, psychology, to medicine and public health) and graduate school preparation by providing communication skills, research skills, and critical thinking.

Applicable Requirements:

I. Attendance of a SSARC Speaker Series Workshop

II. Workshop Component (1 Required)

Attend one (1) SSARC sponsored workshop relating to research or graduate school (i.e., UROP, Honors Program panel, faculty research presentation, graduate school preparation)

III. Experiential Component (1 Required)

Involvement in research through an honors program or verifiable research project such as UROP, SAEP, individual study or directed group study.

IV. Research Methods (1 Required)

Any research methods course taken within the School of Social Sciences is applicable

V. Upper Division Writing (1 Required)

Any upper division writing course taken within the School of Social Sciences is applicable

VI. Statistics (1 Required)

Any statistics course taken within the School of Social Sciences is applicable
